



2023 COMMUNITY PARTNERS SCHOLARSHIP

Due Date: May 1, 2023

The purpose of the Community Partners Scholarship is to provide one (1) semester of assistance to an eligible student in a two or four year college or technical/trade program of study. BWTelcom will award two scholarships of \$1000.00 each.

The following application regulations and methods of selection of winners to the Community Partners Scholarship are listed below.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must be graduating High School seniors who are admitted to an accredited four-year college/university, junior college, or technical/trade school.
2. **REQUIREMENTS: Applicants, parents, or guardians must be current BWTelcom customers.** Applicants must submit the final official high school transcript with a letter of application in addition to the application form. Applications must be submitted to BWTelcom by the school's Principal or Counselor. All applications and letters must be typed – handwritten applications will not be accepted. Please include a senior class picture or current photo of yourself.
3. **BASIS OF SELECTION:**
 - A. Special consideration will be given to those students who desire a Telecommunications or related field of study.
 - B. Academic Standing: Scholastic attainment-rating in class.
 - C. Resume: Resumes are not required but are highly recommended as a supplement to the application. If submitting a resume, please include extracurricular activities in school and the community as well as achievements or honors received during four years of high school (School, Church, and Community). Include any officer positions held.
4. **SELECTION:** Scholarship winners will be selected by BWTelcom's Scholarship Committee. The committee's decision will be final.
5. **SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT:** Scholarship moneys will be paid directly to the college of attendance upon receipt of the awarded student's official transcript of first-semester enrollment. **Transcripts must be submitted to BWTelcom and received by August 31st, 2023. Students who do not provide proof of enrollment or transcripts to BWTelcom by this deadline will risk forfeiting their awarded scholarship.**
