LETTER TO HOUSEHOLD, COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION (CEP)

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that **Wauneta-Palisade School District** will be implementing the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) under the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for **School Year 2024-2025**.

All students enrolled at the Wauneta-Palisade School District are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at <u>no charge</u> to your household each day of the 2024-2025 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

Please note, a la carte items, such as extra milk and juice, are available to students to charge on their household meal account. A completed permission slip will be required for children to do so.
